

2022 Super Fest Southern California COVID-19 Protocols

Date: January 10, 2022



To ensure everyone's comfort and safety at the Super Fest events, we have outlined below the relevant protocols and safety measures that will be in place to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Protocols for all Super Fest participants and volunteers: All Super Fest participants and volunteers ages 5+ will be required to have received a minimum of two doses of a COVID-19 vaccine (Pfizer or Moderna, only one dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine would be necessary). Proof of vaccination will be collected prior to the event and photo identification will be required. For children without photo identification, parents will have to attest to their identity. Participants and volunteers will be required to wear a mask at all times only to be removed when eating or drinking. Exceptions to the vaccination rule will be provided in accordance with the California Department of Public Health Guidelines section 8, which states:

“Workers may be exempt from the vaccination requirements under section (1) only upon providing the employer or employer-recipient a declination form, signed by the individual stating either of the following: (1) the worker is declining vaccination based on Religious Beliefs, or (2) the worker is excused from receiving any COVID-19 vaccine due to Qualifying Medical Reasons.

- a. To be eligible for a Qualified Medical Reasons exemption the worker must also provide to their employer or employer-recipient a written statement signed by a physician, nurse practitioner, or other licensed medical professional practicing under the license of a physician stating that the individual qualifies for the exemption (but the statement should not describe the underlying medical condition or disability) and indicating the probable duration of the worker's inability to receive the vaccine (or if the duration is unknown or permanent, so indicate).”

Participants and volunteers who are unvaccinated will be required to complete a rapid COVID-19 test (provided upon arrival) and must receive a negative test result to enter.

Protocols for Super Fest spectators: Spectators are welcome to watch the weekend's events from the bleachers, however, we ask that masks be worn at all times, in accordance with the [CDPH Guidance for Face Coverings](#). Masks will be made available to spectators upon request. Spectators wishing to eat or drink should do so outside of the bleacher section.

Protocol Updates and Changes to these measures may be made in the weeks leading up to the event, pursuant to public health guidelines in the state of California. We are committed to providing a safe, comfortable environment for all; should you have any questions, comments or concerns regarding these protocols, please contact us via email.

Please Note: For any volunteer, spectator or participant that feels that they may be developing symptoms of COVID19 immediately prior to or during the event, please report this immediately and event staff will assist with local testing and potential isolation.
